

## **TOMBALL CLASSES FOR HOMESCHOOLERS HEALTH & SAFETY PROCEDURES**

- In order to help ensure the health of all students and staff at TCH, we ask that each family make the decision to keep any student home that is ill, especially with a fever of 100 degrees or higher in the past 24 hours or is vomiting or experiencing diarrhea. Teachers and staff make the same commitment.
- If any member of your household comes in close contact with a COVID-positive person, they may choose on of the two quarantine pathways:

1) 7 Day Quarantine with a COVID test at least 5 days into the quarantine—if the test results are negative and no symptoms develop, they may return to class after 7 days since the time of exposure. If the test results are positive or if symptoms develop, then the student needs to quarantine for 10 days and can return to class when ALL 3 statements below are fulfilled:

- A. 3 Days No Fever
- B. Symptoms Improved
- C. 10 Days Have Passed Since Symptoms First Appeared OR Since Testing Positive

2) 10 Day Quarantine with no COVID test—if no symptoms develop, students may return to class after 10 days have passed since the time of exposure. If symptoms develop, then students must meet the same 3 statements listed above.

- Masks will be optional for all TCH teachers, staff, and students. Whether you choose to wear a mask or not, we ask that everyone be respectful of each other's decision.
- Hand sanitizer will be at the sign-in table, study hall tables, and in each classroom. Students are encouraged to use sanitizer upon entering and leaving each area.
- Tables in classrooms and study hall will be cleaned at the start and end of each class day.
- Drinking fountains will be off limits so make sure students bring enough water for their stay on campus
